Who will meet me at the airport?

You will fly into Dublin Airport and be met by ISAIreland staff.

Where will I be met at the airport?

You must exit the baggage carousel and walk through to the ARRIVALS area. On the left as you exit (your left) there is a meeting point. There will be staff with ISAIreland and AFS Signs. Niamh (your leader in Ireland) will be wearing a bright pink jacket.

How will I recognize the ISAI staff at the airport?

We will be holding signs that say AFS and wearing pink

How will I get to the orientation site?

Your group will travel by bus.

Where will the orientation take place?

The orientation will take place at the program grounds in Donegal County, where you will be living for the entire program.

Will I get a tour of the city during the orientation?

You may get some sightseeing on the drive over from Dublin and on the first day, you will get a tour of the local town and area.

How long is the orientation?

The first day is an orientation of the campus, the beaches and the local area.

What type of activities will happen during orientation?

There is Wi-Fi in your campus accommodation. Most students use wifi to contact home. However, phones are available if not.

Any other useful information I should know?

You will need a converter for chargers and appliances. Please get a UK (NOT EURO) converter, or a universal converter. You can buy this in the airport.
