RECOMMENDED TOOLS

- A large screen or projector on which to display webpages and videos in class.
- Devices for students to explore resources, and start applying for, Project: Change online.
- If you can't access laptops or tablets, consider reserving your computer lab.

BEFORE CLASS

IN CLASS

- Introduce the definition of a changemaker, the concept of sustainable development, and The Global Goals using the resources that best fit your class.
- If you decide to use one of the UN's longer lesson plans, go ahead! If not, break up your class into smaller groups to discuss. Have each group appoint a speaker to share answers to the following questions:
 - What is sustainable development and why is it important for life on Earth?
 - What is one way we can help meet the Sustainable Development Goals at home?
 - How can we help other communities by listening to their needs and collaborating?
- Introduce Project: Change by showing our homepage and the Learn tab on a big screen.
- Hand out the Project: Change Application Process and Changemaking Cycle for reference.
- Get students on computers or other devices to let them explore our website and create an account for their submission to the scholarship contest.
